



## Our Father's Lutheran School Cell Phones/Electronic Devices Policy

July 2024

- It is suggested that all students leave their electronic devices at home. "Electronic devices" are defined as, but not limited to: cell phones, tablets, and smart watches.
- If they choose to bring any such devices to school, students must turn them in to their teacher. All devices will be kept in the classroom in a locked container for the day. Students may request to use a device only in the case of an emergency. Devices not turned in will be confiscated and given to the principal. Confiscated items may only be claimed by the student's parents.
- Electronic devices are prohibited at school-sponsored activities and should never be used in private areas such as restrooms and locker rooms.
- Any conflicts between students after school hours due to inappropriate cell phone/social media usage are outside of school jurisdiction; however, any conflicts that transfer from outside of school to the school day will be handled by teachers and administration accordingly.
